So, you're looking at having some clothing sublimated and wanted to know a bit more about what you can do. Well, let's get started!

What is Sublimation?

Sublimation is a dying process used to dye the entirety of a piece of clothing. We take a white, 100% polyester garment and use a special dying process which transfers dye directly to the clothing using high temperature and pressure, so your design will never come out!

What can I do with it?

Simply put? You can have pretty much ANYTHING you want! This allows for unprecedented levels of customisation.

- ✓ Complex, all-over patterns and designs.
- ✓ 'Fake' Panels in any configuration you want.
- ✓ Gradients.
- ✓ As many colours as you want.
- ✓ Any number of logos.
- ✓ Individual Names.
- ✓ Individual Numbers.

How can I show you what I want?

There's loads of ways you can do this - you don't have to be an artist to design a great kit! Many of our customers send us designs they have drawn themselves which our graphic designer reworks for them. We also get customers who simply tell us in an email what they would like and we try and come up with a design for them.
